

# **Exactor Lite**

### **Who Uses:**

Performance horse trainers who require higher levels of fat and fibre, but lower carbohydrates in a diet. Exactor Lite will prove beneficial to horses demonstrating stomach ulcers.

### **Description**

A textured energy ration for race and sport horses, in competition, requiring concentrated energy from fat and beet pulp to sustain performance, weight gain and power. Feed along with hay.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Contains added fat from vegetable oil.</li></ul>	Increases energy density to elevate calorie intake for the same amount of ration. Increases muscle glycogen content, over time (10-12 weeks).
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• No corn included in Exactor Lite.</li></ul>	Reduces the risk of rapid acid production in large intestine that may cause colic, founder and/or diarrhea when adjusting to a higher, total grain intake.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Contains yeast culture.</li></ul>	Lowers gut acidity; produces enzymes that extract more energy and protein from hay and all other fibre sources.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Contains high level of Vitamin E.</li></ul>	A powerful antioxidant to enhance immune response and improve tissue regeneration after strenuous exercise.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Contains 40mg/kg copper.</li></ul>	Involved in hemoglobin formation and bone developments. Important for good health.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Contains chelated trace minerals.</li></ul>	For increased bio-availability of those nutrients essential for immune response, hoof health, bone and cartilage development.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Designed for feeding with hay.</li></ul>	Advanced nutrition to balance hay feeding for genetically superior performance horses in training.

### **Directions for Use:**

Any switch to a high fat ration should be made gradually over a 15 day period. For the first 5 days, replace  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the existing grain ration with Exactor Lite. Then replace  $\frac{1}{2}$  the grain ration with Exactor Lite for the next 5 days. On day 11, offer  $\frac{3}{4}$  Exactor Lite and  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the former ration. On day 16, feed all Exactor Lite. Hay should also be available. Make the change to Exactor Lite first, then alter quantity to support condition. Water and salt should be available, free choice, at all times.
