Poultry Feed Guide

Broiler Feed			
RWA 20% Poultry Starter/Grower •	0-3 wks	2 kg per bird over 3 wks	1 bag for 12 birds over 3 wk period
RWA 16% Poultry Grower/Finish •	3+ wks	1.5 kg per bird per wk	1 bag for 12-16 birds per week
Pullet/Layer Feed			
RWA 20% Poultry Starter/Grower •	0-6 wks	1.5 kg per bird over 6 wks	1 bag for 15 birds over 6 wk period
RWA 16% Poultry Grower/Finish •	6-18 wks	6 kgs per bird over 11 wks	1 bag for 45-50 birds per week
17% AV Layer Ration	18+ wks	Aprox 120 grams per bird per day	1 bag for 30 birds per week
Turkey/Game Bird Feed			
RWA 25% Turkey Game Bird Starter	0-4 wks	2 kg per bird over 4 wks	1 bag for 12-13 birds over 4 wk period
RWA 20% Turkey Grower	5-10 wks	8 kg per hen, 10 kg per tom over 5 wk period	1 bag for 10-15 birds per week
RWA 16% Poultry Grower/Finish •	11-18 wks	4 kg per bird per week	1 bag for 6 birds per week
Duck/Goose Feed			
RWA 20% Poultry Starter/Grower •	0-4 wks 0-6 wks	Ducks: 2.5 kg per bird over time frame Geese: 6.5 kg per bird over time frame	Ducks: 1 bag for 10 birds over 4 wk period Geese: 1 bag for 3-4 birds over 6 wk period
RWA 16% Poultry Grower/Finish •	5-10 wks 7-finish	Ducks: 1.25 kg per bird per week Geese: 2 kg per bird per week	Ducks: 1 bag for 20 birds per week Geese: 1 bag for 10-12 birds per week
